



Colorful Days

1 Look at the front cover of the book. What is the title of the book? What does this tell you about what will be inside the book?

2 Turn to the “pink” page (pages 10–11). What are “blossoms”? Can you name all the other pictures on this page?

3 Turn to the “yellow” page (pages 16–17). What pictures can you see? What do all these things have in common? Is this the same for the pages for other colors in the book?

4 Look at the glossary at the back of the book. Now look at the “orange” and “red” pages (pages 18–21). What do you notice about the pictures and text in the glossary? What does this tell you that a glossary is for?

Answers

- 1 Colorful Days; that the book will be about different colors in the world around us
- 2 flowers on plants and trees; teddy bear, flower, ballet shoes, toy pig (or piggy bank), balloon
- 3 butterflies, sunflower, bucket / pail, ball of yarn, toy ducks, lemon, bananas; they are all yellow; yes
- 4 The glossary pictures and text are the same as those on the “orange” and “red” pages; A glossary is a useful summary of key information from the book.
