# SUMMER DAY CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS



Indy Parks offers limited day camp scholarships to children of all ages based on financial need. Financial assistance may range from 50% to 100%. This does not include deposits. Children must live in Marion County to be eligible. Follow steps below to apply for a scholarship

Register for camp with a \$5 non-refundable deposit, per camper, per week. Registration must be completed at the camp location or the Indy Parks Customer Service Center.

After payment is made, request the scholarship application
