

### **ABOUT INDY PARKS**

Indy Parks and Recreation provides parks, greenspaces, trails, and recreation opportunities for Marion County residents and visitors. The agency serves 8 million people annually and offers 212 parks, 11,258 acres of greenspace, 130 playgrounds, 155 sports fields, 153 miles of trails, 23 recreation and nature centers, 19 aquatic centers, 21 spray grounds, 13 golf courses, and four dog parks. Indy Parks also provides more than 2,400 sports, art, education, and recreation programs throughout the year.

### REGISTRATION

Registration begins Monday, January 31, 2022.

To secure your camper's spot, you must complete all registration forms and pay a \$15 non-refundable registration fee per registered week per child at the time of registration. The remaining balance will be due by 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday before the week of camp begins. Failure to meet the Wednesday payment deadline will result in your child's name being removed from the registration list. Note: some specialty camps require payment in full at registration.

### **Day Camp Refund Policy**

Indy Parks will issue a full refund if the camp is canceled.

If a camper is withdrawn from a camp at the Garfield Park Arts Center, Southeastway Park, Eagle Creek Park, or Holliday Park, notice must be received at least two weeks before the first day of camp. A refund will be issued, but the \$15 registration fee will not be refunded. This \$15 fee is nontransferable. If the camper is withdrawn less than two weeks before the first day of camp, a 50% refund will be given. If a camper is withdrawn from a traditional camp or a GATHER camp, a refund will be issued, but the \$15 registration fee will not be refunded. This \$15 fee is nontransferable.

If a medical emergency occurs after the two week deadline, a refund will be issued, but the \$15 registration fee will not be refunded. A written note from a physician is required for a refund in the event of a medical emergency.

All refunds could take up to six weeks.

### **Counselors**

All Indy Parks Summer Day Camp counselors are over the age of 16 and participate in more than 30 hours of camp programming training before camp begins. All counselors are CPR and First Aid certified and have passed a complete background and criminal history check. All staff have been selected for their experience, special talents, sensitivity, and creativity.

### **COVID-19 GUIDELINES**

Indy Parks is committed to providing a safe summer day camp experience. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, precautions have been put in place for public health and safety. Indy Parks will use information provided by local and state health authorities and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for guidance.

- Campers and counselors are required to wear face coverings while inside.
- Camps may have a reduced number of maximum participants.
- Indy Parks reserves the right to modify or cancel an activity if it cannot be done in a safe manner.
- Supplies and camp spaces will be sanitized regularly.
- Activities will take place outside when appropriate.
- Campers and counselors will practice social distancing and good hygiene in accordance with CDC guidelines.
- If a counselor reports that a camper is showing symptoms of COVID-19, the head counselor will be notified immediately to evaluate the camper. The camper may be sent home if they begin to show signs/symptoms of COVID-19 or any other communicable disease. The lead counselor will isolate the camper from others until a parent or guardian arrives. Everything the camper touched will be sanitized immediately. Parents or guardians will have 45 minutes to pick up the camper. The ill camper will not be able to return to camp until they are symptom-free for at least 72 hours.
- If a camper tests positive for COVID-19 or any other communicable illness, they will need to follow the CDC recommendations for isolation.
- Parents must immediately notify park staff if a camper tests positive for a communicable disease.
- In the event a camper or counselor tests positive for COVID-19 or any other communicable disease after camp has started, all parents and guardians will be notified that someone at the camp is potentially infectious, and camp may be shut down for a minimum of two weeks for thorough cleaning and quarantining. The camp director will keep track of all reported cases and will notify the Indiana State Department of Health for further instructions.
- Indy Parks staff will communicate any changes or updates regarding COVID-19 guidelines.
