

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

How to enable GrabPay as a Payment Method




1. Initiate Installation

Note: You are not able to limit the checkout to qualify shoppers to use PayLater.



FAQs

What is the PayLater Promote Shopify app?

The PayLater Promote Shopify app allows merchants who accept PayLater by Grab to display an instalments display on their product pages. An instalments display will allow your customers to better visualize PayLater payment plans and drive greater sales. For example, an item priced at \$299 will be displayed as \$74.75 x4 with PayLater by Grab.



Do I need a Shopify store before I can install the PayLater Promote app?

Yes, the PayLater app is available for Shopify stores only. Please sign-up and setup your Shopify store before you install the app. Visit the [PayLater Integrations Launchpad](#) for more information about installing Price Dividers for other shop builders.

Can I choose a different colourway option so that it fits better with my store design language?

Currently we have one version of the PayLater Instalments Display.

Can I choose to have only one provider's instalments display showing or show multiple?

Yes, you can disable other provider's instalments display or choose to show multiple instalments displays.

FAQs

Can I hide this for certain products / SKUs?

You can define the minimum and maximum order value for which the instalments display will be shown. If the item price is below the minimum amount or above the maximum value, the instalments display will not be shown. Go to PayLater app to change the settings.

Do I need to sign-up to accept GrabPay or PayLater before I install the PayLater app?

Yes, please [sign-up as a GrabPay merchant](#) before you can accept GrabPay and PayLater and install the PayLater app.

If I do not want to show the PayLater Instalments Display, can I turn it off?

It's optional! But the PayLater Instalments Display has been proven to be a great tool to further drive conversion by visualizing how PayLater works. To turn off the price divider tool, go to the PayLater app > click on the status toggle.

We are working on it! Please note that changing the minimum order amount in the PayLater Promote app will not restrict users from using PayLater at your checkout. The minimum order amount in the PayLater plugin allows you to choose when to show the instalments display.



How to install the GrabPay Plugin




1. Install GrabPay Plugin



- Download the plugin package at <https://cdn-gp01.grabpay.com/woocommerce/v2.0.3/grab-paylater.zip>
- Go to your **WordPress admin** dashboard
- Navigate to **Admin > Plugins > Add New > Upload Plugin**

2. Upload GrabPay Plugin



- Select the **downloaded zip file** (grab-paylater.zip)
- Click **Install Now**

3. Enter Server Details



- In particular, note that **payment has only been received, after Order Status reaches the Processing status**



- Go to Wordpress Admin panel > **WooCommerce** > **Settings** > **Emails**
- Check the **Recipients** column to ensure that the correct parties are notified for each Status
- **Enabled** notifications have a **purple check mark** beside it
- **Disabled** notifications have a **grey cross mark** beside it

Important

If you wish to receive notifications for unpaid orders (e.g. On-Hold), do ensure that you are able to differentiate these notifications from those that have been paid.



- Click into the template name or **Manage**, and ensure that the ***Enable this email notification*** checkbox is marked accordingly




1. Check your plugin version




- **Latest version: 2.0.3** (as of 23 June 2021)
- Navigate to Wordpress Admin panel > Plugins > Installed Plugins
- Look for **WooCommerce GrabPay Gateway** and check the version as per screenshot

2a. Updating Plugin



- Navigate to Wordpress Admin panel > Plugins > Installed Plugins > find **WooCommerce GrabPay Gateway**, and click **Deactivate**
- Download latest plugin files from: <https://cdn-gp01.grabpay.com/woocommerce/v2.0.3/grab-paylater.zip>

2b. Updating Plugin (continued)



- In your Wordpress host directory, replace the existing plugin files in: **wp-content/plugins/woocommerce-e-gateway-grabpay ***
- Go to Wordpress Admin panel > Plugins again and click **Activate Plugin**
- Perform a few test transactions to ensure there are no issues

*** Note**

Depending on your hosting provider, you may need to use a FTP transfer application e.g. Filezilla to perform this step

FAQs

What is the GrabPay WooCommerce plugin?

The PayLater WooCommerce plugin allows merchants who accept GrabPay and PayLater as payment methods in their online store.

The plugin also allows merchants who accept PayLater to display an instalments display on their product pages. An instalments display will allow your customers to better visualize PayLater payment plans and drive greater sales. For example, an item priced at \$199 will be displayed as \$49.75 x4 with PayLater by Grab.

Do I need a WooCommerce store before I can install the GrabPay app?

Yes, the GrabPay app is available for WooCommerce stores only. Please sign-up and setup your WooCommerce store before you install the plugin.

Do I need to sign-up to accept GrabPay or PayLater before I install the PayLater app?

Yes, you will have to go to this [website](#) and sign-up as a GrabPay merchant before you can accept GrabPay and PayLater and install the PayLater app.

Can I choose different colour options for the PayLater Instalments Display?

Can I choose to have only one provider's instalments display showing or show multiple?




The brand name that appears in the GrabPay checkout screen is incorrect.


The GrabPay plugin gets the Brand Name from your site name. Please update your site name by going to Settings > General Settings > Update Site Title.

How do I retrieve Plugin logs? (may be required for plugin troubleshooting)

Go to your Wordpress admin panel > WooCommerce > Status > Logs, then select the log you wish to obtain from the dropdown menu

What is my redirect url and webhook url?

We will need the redirect url and webhook url to send users back to your website after they have completed their transactions.

FAQs

What is this Error? - “Cron job is not running. Please make sure cron job is configured correctly.”

For Order status to move from one status to another, cron job needs to be configured correctly. For example, orders stuck in “Payment Pending” will not move to “Failed”, if Cron job is not configured correctly. Please contact your developer or hosting provider to configure cron settings.

Can I use the plugin if I have multiple URLs?

The plugin does not work for multiple URLs currently. We are looking to enhance the plugin in future versions, and will keep you updated!

What is the minimum WordPress and WooCommerce versions that are compatible with the GrabPay plugin?

The plugin will work on WordPress 5.7 and WooCommerce 5.1.0. If your website is on the old WordPress or WooCommerce versions, please update [WordPress](#) and [WooCommerce](#) to the latest version.

Help! I tried installing the GrabPay plugin but its not working.

Ensure that you are using the [correct version of the plugin](#). Additionally, do ensure that the [minimum and maximum order amount](#) is set correctly.
