PROJECT DETAILS

The first phase will improve drainage by installing large-diameter stormwater pipes along 33rd Street, Orchard Street and 32nd Street from Fall Creek to Keystone Avenue. The improvements will support current and future projects associated with the 38th Street & Olney Drainage Improvement project. PROJECT DETAILS

The project's second phase will install large-diameter storm sewers that tie into the South Keystone project at 32nd Street and Keystone. New storm sewers will be placed along 32nd Street, Temple Avenue, 34th Street and Rural Street before connecting with Minnie Creek. The project includes drainage improvements between 32nd and 34th Streets and pavement resurfacing on Temple Avenue, as well as new detention ponds within Washington Park. Over 100 new native trees, shrubs, grasses and plantings will be introduced in and along the Minnie Creek channel to restore its natural condition. Learn more at indy.gov/dpw.
