

## “TIC TAC FESTIVAL 2024” PROMOTION

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

<b>Promoter</b>	Ferrero Australia Pty Ltd (ABN 29 001 249 261), Level 36, 100 Miller Street, North Sydney NSW 2060.
<b>Competition Period</b>	Entries open at 12:00am AEST (2:00am NZST) on 22/04/24 and close at 11:59pm AEST on 23/06/24 (1:59am NZST on 24/06/24).
<b>Who can enter?</b>	Only Australian and New Zealand residents who are aged 18 or over who can attend the Splendour in the Grass 2024 festival in NSW, Australia.
<b>Who can't enter?</b>	Directors, officers, management and employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, participating retailers and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
<b>Where will the competition run?</b>	The competition will run in all retailers (including online) in Australia and all retailers (excluding online) in New Zealand that stock Tic Tac products (each a “Store”).

<b>Qualifying Purchase</b>	To be eligible to enter, entrants must purchase any specially marked 24g or 49g Tic Tac pack (“ <b>Eligible Product</b> ”) from a Store during the Competition Period (“ <b>Qualifying Purchase</b> ”). Each specially marked 24g or 49g Tic Tac pack will contain a unique code located inside the pack (“ <b>Unique Code</b> ”).
<b>Entry instructions</b>	To enter, entrants must, during the Competition Period: (a) visit the Website and follow the prompts to the promotion entry page; (b) input the requested details including full name, email address, postal address, phone number, Store of Qualifying Purchase; (c) input the Unique Code; (d) check the box consenting to personal information being stored and managed in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and the Promoter’s privacy policy; and (e) submit the fully completed online entry form (each an “ <b>Entry</b> ”).

Winners will be published on the Website each Monday from 29/04/24.</p> <p>A maximum of 6 instant prizes are available for weeks 1–8 of the Competition Period and a maximum of 2 instant prizes available for week 9 of the Competition Period (Monday – Sunday).</p> <p>Every valid entry submitted will also be entered into the Major Draw (as detailed below).</p> <p><b>Draw:</b>            There will be one (1) draw conducted for all entries received during the Competition Period. <b>What can I win?</b>	<p><b>Instant Prizes:</b>            There are 50 instant prizes available.</p> <p>Each instant winner will receive one (1) General Admission (GA) 3-day pass for entry into the Splendour in the Grass 2024 festival valued at AU\$429.00. Each pass only allows the winner entry into the general event site only.</p>

	<p>Winners are responsible for arranging their own travel to and from the festival as well as any accommodation, passports, visas or other documentation required to attend the festival.</p> <p><b>Draw Prize:</b> There is one (1) Draw prize available.</p> <p>The winner of the Draw will win a Splendour in the Grass pack for two (2) people valued at AU\$2,798.00. <b>How and when will the winner/s be published?</b>	<p>Instant prize winners will be notified instantly upon submitting their entry and will be published on the Website each Monday from 29/04/24.</p> <p>The Draw prize winner will be notified by email and published within two (2) business days of the Draw (27/06/24).</p>
<b>Proof of purchase</b>	<p>You must keep the following as proof of purchase for all entries:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Copy of purchase receipt for Qualifying Purchase.</li> </ul> <p>If you do not produce the above proof of purchase for all entries when asked the Promoter may disqualify all of your entries and you will lose any right to a prize. Proof of purchase must be identical to that provided by you with your entry. If, in the Promoter's opinion, you have shared any proof of purchase with another person, your entries will be invalid and you will lose any right to a prize.</p>

### Entry

- 2 Your entry must be received during the Competition Period and will be deemed to be received only when received by the Promoter. If you return a Qualifying Purchase your entry may be deemed invalid at the Promoter's discretion (unless the product is defective). You will receive a return message confirming your entry. The Promoter is not liable for any problems with communications networks. You are responsible for your own costs associated with entering including costs associated with accessing the promotional website. If you enter using automatically generated entries or multiple phone numbers/email addresses/addresses/aliases, you will be disqualified.

### Prizes

### General

- 8 Any failure by you to comply with the conditions imposed by the prize supplier(s) may result in the prize being cancelled or withdrawn without liability for the Promoter or the prize supplier(s).
- 9 If you or your entry are deemed by the Promoter to breach these Terms and Conditions, your entry (or at the Promoter's discretion, all of your entries) may be discarded.
- 10 The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these Terms and Conditions, tampered with the entry process or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise fair and proper conduct of the promotion. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

- The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
- 11 If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
- 12 You must not:
- (f) tamper with the entry process;
  - (g) engage in any conduct that may jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the competition;
  - (h) act in a disruptive, annoying, threatening, abusive or harassing manner;
  - (i) do anything that may diminish the good name or reputation of the Promoter or any of its related entities or of the agencies or companies associated with this competition;
  - (j) breach any law; or
  - (k) behave in a way that is otherwise inappropriate.
- 13 The Promoter is not liable for entries, prize claims or correspondence that are misplaced, misdirected, delayed, lost, incomplete, indecipherable or incorrectly submitted. Incomplete or indecipherable entries will be deemed invalid.
- 14 The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 15 Prizes, or any unused portion of a prize, cannot be transferred or exchanged nor redeemed for cash, unless otherwise specified.
- 16 Without limiting any other term of these Terms and Conditions and subject to the unclaimed prize draw clause, all prizes (and elements of prizes) must be taken as and when specified, or will be forfeited with no replacement. The prize values are correct as at the date of preparing these Terms and Conditions and include any applicable GST. The Promoter is not responsible for any change in prize value. You agree that if a prize (or element of a prize) is unavailable for any reason the Promoter may provide another item of equal or higher value and/or specification, subject to any necessary approval by the relevant gaming authorities
- 17 The use of any automated entry software or any other mechanical or electronic means that allows an entrant to automatically enter repeatedly is prohibited and will render all entries submitted by that entrant invalid.
- 18 Any cost associated with accessing the promotional website is the entrant's responsibility and is dependent on the Internet service provider used.
- 19 If this competition cannot run as planned for any reason beyond the Promoter's control, for example due to software, hardware or communications issues, unauthorised intervention, tampering, fraud or technical failure, the Promoter may end, change, suspend or cancel the competition or disqualify affected entries/entrants, subject to any necessary approval by the relevant gaming authorities. - 20 In the event of war, terrorism, state of emergency, government lockdown, pandemic, or any other kind of disaster or unforeseeable event beyond the Promoter's reasonable control, the Promoter reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the promotion or suspend, substitute or modify a prize, subject to any written directions from a relevant regulatory authority.
- 21 Quality control errors will not invalidate an otherwise valid prize claim. Unless otherwise due to fraud or ineligibility under these Terms and Conditions, all prize claims in excess of the advertised prize pool will be honoured.
- 22 The Promoter is not responsible for any tax implications arising from you winning a prize. You should seek independent financial advice. For Australian residents, if for GST purposes this competition results in any supply being made for non-monetary consideration, you must follow the Australian Taxation Office's stated view that where the parties are at arm's length, goods and services exchanged are of equal GST inclusive market values.

## **Liability**

- 23 Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits, excludes or modifies or purports to limit, exclude or modify the statutory consumer guarantees as provided under the Competition and Consumer Act, as well as any other implied warranties under the ASIC Act or similar consumer protection laws in the States and Territories of Australia or any statutory consumer guarantees as provided under consumer protection laws in New Zealand ("Non-Excludable Guarantees"). Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) and the prize suppliers excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the promotion.
- 24 Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable

Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) and the prize suppliers are not responsible for and excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) if the Splendour in the Grass 2024 festival is delayed, postponed or cancelled for any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (f) any tax liability incurred by a winner or entrant; or (g) use of / taking of the prize.
