Alejandro Leon Barroso will serve 52 years for 2021 murder of Oswaldo Cruz Lopez

Barroso fired five rounds at his coworker, Lopez, after an altercation

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. – Marion County Prosecutor Ryan Mears announced today that the Alejandro Leon Barroso has been sentenced to 52 years in the Indiana Department of Correction for the 2021 shooting death of Oswaldo Cruz Lopez. Barroso was convicted of Murder after a two-day jury trial.

On May 24, 2021, Barroso and Lopez were working at an apartment complex near 38th and Mitthoefer Road. While in a vacant apartment Barroso and Lopez had a brief altercation before Barroso retaliated by firing five rounds and fatally wounding Lopez.

According to other employees at the complex, Barroso came to them after the incident and explained that he had just shot Lopez. Upon arrival, officers detained Barroso and recovered a firearm and magazines surrendered at the front desk.
