Man found guilty of September 2020 shooting death of Christopher Greene

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. – Marion County Prosecutor Ryan Mears announced today that Edward Smith has been convicted of Murder and Carrying a Handgun Without a License (A Misdemeanor) for the 2020 shooting death of Christopher Greene. Smith was convicted after a three-day jury trial.

After Smith and a woman in a nearby residence had an altercation, Greene allowed the woman to stay in his residence to get away from Smith until tensions lowered. The next morning Smith returned to Greene's residence and asked him to open the door. When Greene opened the door, Smith shot him in the chest and fled the scene on a bicycle. There were two witnesses inside the residence at the time of the murder.

Shortly after the murder, Smith was located on his bicycle by police.

A sentencing hearing has been set for Aug. 6 at 3 p.m. in Criminal Court 30.
