

# Teaching vocabulary

**Word class/es noun**

## Definition:

A special anniversary of an event, especially celebrating the reign of a king or queen.

## Example:

In 2022, the Queen will celebrate her Platinum Jubilee.

# Jubilee

## Syllables:

**ju-bi-lee**

## Synonyms:

anniversary, celebration, festival, commemoration

## Word origin (etymology)

**French** - Late 14C, from Old French 'jubilee meaning jubilee; anniversary; rejoicing'

**Latin** - *iubilaus* meaning 'the jubilee year'

**Greek** - *iabelaios*, from *iobelos*, from Hebrew *yobhel* 'jubilee'

## Example:

The Queen's coronation was the first in Britain to be fully televised.

## Definition:

The ceremony of crowning a king or queen.

# Coronation

**Syllables:**  
**cor-o-na-tion**

**Synonyms:**  
crowning, enthroning

**Word origin  
(etymology)**

**Late Latin** - *coronationem*  
'a crowning'

**Latin** - *coronare* 'to furnish with a crown' from *corona*  
'crown, wreath'

# Teaching vocabulary

Word class/es noun

## Definition:

A crowned head of state, especially a king, queen, or emperor.

## Example:

The Queen is the longest-serving British monarch in history.

# Monarch

**Syllables:**  
**mon-arch**

**Synonyms:**  
king, queen, Crown,  
crowned head



## Word origin (etymology)

**Mid-15c.**, *monark*, 'supreme governor for life, a sole or autocratic ruler of a state', from **Old French** *monarche*

**Greek** - *monarkhēs* 'one who rules alone'

**mono-**

Word-forming element of Greek origin meaning 'one, single, alone; containing one'

Word class/es noun/verb

## Definition:

*Noun:*

the time that a monarch (king or queen) rules.

*Verb:*

to rule as a monarch.

**Syllables:**  
**reign**

**Synonyms:**  
rule, monarchy

## Example:

The Queen's reign began in 1952.

# Reign

## Word origin (etymology)

From **Latin** *regnum*, 'kingship, dominion, rule, realm', which is related to *regere* 'to rule'
