Ryan has a devotion to youth mentorship and entrepreneurship and provides an after-school work program to teach younger generations the basics of running a small business. Ryan also founded the <u>National Aviation Youth Resources</u> (NAYR) Foundation, a nonprofit devoted to teaching youth about the Aviation industry.

"I am grateful and happy to receive this award from the city I admire so much," said owner Ryan Lynch. "I hope to continue my work for the community through my business and my nonprofit and be able to connect with more youth and help them achieve their ultimate career goals."

The Vendor of the Month initiative was created by OMWBD to bring additional attention to certified minority, women, veteran, and disabled-owned business enterprises (XBEs) that are making a positive difference across Indianapolis neighborhoods.
