Data collection of business services 2023

The inquiry concerns the distribution of your enterprise's turnover by product category in 2023. In addition, please specify possible sales to households (private customers) by product category. The inquiry concerns enterprises whose accounting period ended during 2023.

Data are inquired from enterprises in service industries and also from certain enterprises in other industries that have service production. Depending on the industry, the data are inquired from enterprises with at least five or 20 employees and in certain cases from smaller enterprises than that either yearly or every two years. All the largest enterprises in the industries are included and smaller enterprises are included in the inquiry based on random sampling.

How to respond

Please respond with the electronic form. You can also respond using a mobile device. The Internet address of the inquiry and the login identifiers for your enterprise are in the top right-hand corner of this letter. You can also utilise the Suomi.fi authorisation service by The Digital and Population Data Services Agency. Statistics Finland's Suomi.fi mandate is responding to data collections from enterprises and organisations and defining specifier is pahy. What are the data used for

The statistics compiled based on the inquiry data are published on 20th of December 2024 at https://stat.fi/en/statistics/palhy. The collected data are also utilised in the compilation of the Producer Price Index for Services and in the national accounts. The data will also be used in the EU's production of statistics, in compilation of other economic statistics, and in scientific research. Further information on the obligation to provide data and treatment of the data

Confidentiality, data protection and publicity

Statistics Finland uses the data for the compilation of statistics. Unit level data collected for statistical purposes must be kept confidential by virtue of Section 24, Paragraph 1, Sub-paragraph 16 of the Act on the Openness of Government Activities (621/1999). According to Section 13 of the Statistics Act (280/2004), Statistics Finland may also release data for scientific studies and statistical surveys without data enabling direct identification. Statistics Finland may release data with their identification data to another Finnish statistical authority for the purpose of compilation of statistics on an activity falling within its sphere of influence, for cooperation between national statistical institutes, for cooperation between national statistical institutes, to the EuroGroups Register of multinational enterprises and to the Bank of Finland for the development, production, and quality improvement of the European statistics for which it is responsible. According to Section 12 of the Statistics Act, data describing the activities and public service production of central and local government authorities that are public based on other legislation are also public as statistical data. The collected data concerning individual persons are treated confidentially and they are used only for statistical purposes. The data are protected against unauthorised access in accordance with the data protection rules adopted by Statistics Finland. The Statistics Act prohibits the use of data collected for statistical purposes in an investigation, surveillance, legal proceedings, administrative decision-making, or other similar handling of a matter concerning the enterprise. Unit-level data on enterprises may only be handled at Statistics Finland by persons whose tasks require the use of such data. Obligation to provide data

The obligation to provide data is based on Sections 14 and 15 of the Finnish Statistics Act (280/2004). Notwithstanding the provisions on data secrecy, entrepreneurs are obliged to provide Statistics Finland with such data that are necessary for the compilation of statistics. By virtue of Section 21 of the Statistics Act, Statistics Finland is entitled to receive these data free of charge.

By virtue of Section 8 of the Statistics Act, data providers have the right to seek exemption from the obligation to provide data wholly or partially if the provision of data causes the respondent unreasonable inconvenience and the exemption will not essentially hamper the production of statistics or weaken the reliability and usability of statistics. Unreasonable inconvenience refers to putting the respondent in an unequal position with regard to other data providers. Duration of storage

Digital statistical data formed from the supplied data are permanently stored at Statistics Finland in accordance with the National Archives of Finland's confirmed storage period decision (KA/19843/07.01.01.03.01/2017).

The regulations of the European Union in part require the collection of the data in question (Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council (Council Regulation No 295/2008 concerning structural business statistics).
