






# The 2024 General Assembly extended the project's statutory deadline by one year to July 1, 2026


















# AlexRenew's Lifeline Emergency Assistance Program launches May 17, 2024



# Application Requirements







Must be an AlexRenew account holder

Have a past-due balance of \$100 (\$50 if over 62)

Income ≤ 150% of the federal poverty level

- Applicants receive a max disbursement of \$350 per year
- A sincere effort of payment amount of \$50 is required for a disbursement (\$25 for senior citizen)

### How do eligible customers receive LEAP funds?


LEAP funds are transferred from Dollar Energy to AlexRenew to be directly applied to customer accounts within AlexRenew's customer care system.



# History of AlexRenew arrearages





## Summary of AlexRenew's current delinquencies

- Disconnections suspended since Mar 2020, resulting in a \$1.5 million total arrearage
  - Half of the total arrearage value are residential
  - 1,300 residential and 225 commercial accounts are delinquent
- AlexRenew has reached out to delinquent customers since Apr 2023
- Disconnection process to resume in Mar 2024
  - Process takes approximately 90 days
  - Virginia American Water performs disconnections
  - First disconnections are anticipated in Jul 2024
- LEAP is designed to limit disconnections to those struggling to pay their bill
- AlexRenew will not disconnect water for anyone with a documented serious medical condition or current with a payment plan

Environmental justice is the equitable treatment and meaningful engagement of our residents—inclusive of all races, cultures, first-ties, neighborhoods, and incomes—ove may advance our mission in managing the community's weatowater without placing disproportionate environmental burdens on those we serve. Our work for environmental justice should be intentional and inspectful.

As a single-purpose utility established to manage the community's wastewater, Alexiflenew operates and maintains infrastructure that is designed to protect public health and improve the environment. <u>Asymptotic</u> environments justice commitment will be guided by meaningful engigement and informed actions to best serve our community. As such, Alexiflenew commits to the following actions to promote the goals of environmental laustice:

- Assess App Security, existing infrastructure, programs, and projects to identify any potential disproportionate environmental disparities and impacts on those we serve. Develop strategies to address those disparities and impacts through operations and capital investments, including timetables for insilementation.
- Conduct environmental justice training on a routine basis to ensure staff are equipped with the
  appropriate resources to understand the importance, issues, and impacts of AlexBonaw's programs.
- Develop and implement guidance on the inclusion of environmental justice considerations, procedures
  and outcomes in appropriate AlexRenew programs.
- Meaningfully engage stakeholders from a broad cross-section of the community, including socioeconomically vulnerable residents and groups that have been underrepresented in past decision making processes, during all phases of major programs that have potential to impact the community.
- Practice active listening to understand community impacts associated with AlexSequita programs.
- Develop diverse and culturally appropriate communication strategies to ensure that stakeholders can
  participate in decisions and actions that may impact our community.
- Create engaging and intentional educational programs to ensure that residents understand the value of their investment in clean water.
- . Make decisions with an understanding of the community's residents, history, and economy
- Develop funding strategies to support equitable and affordable sewer rates within our legal abilities, while implementing and advocating with the City and other utilities for initiatives that offer financial assistance to those in need.
- Coordinate with the City of Alexandria to provide community benefit as part of major programs to help tell the history of disadvantaged populations, where appropriate and practicable.
- Support the City of Alexandria and other public and private entities to establish, strengthen, and
  maintain key partnerships with community-based, non-profit, faith-based organizations, and businesse
  in Alexandria to develop and support affordshifty, and anxironmental lustics initiations.
- Continuously improve upon ¿localony/a programs using best available information as new knowledge becomes available.

- Assess AlexRenew's existing infrastructure and programs—develop strategies to address any disparities
- Develop guidance and conduct training
- Meaningfully engage stakeholders and practice active listening
- Develop diverse communication strategies and engaging educational programs


