✓ What is Walking Football

As the name suggests a game of football where all players walk during a match. No running or jogging is allowed and although this is a no contact sport we do permit minimal soft physical contact . The purpose of Walking Football is for players to be active as long as possible and where players of all ages and ability can play together.

✓ Why Walking Football

You're here to make new friends, become part of the community and stay as fit as is appropriate for your age. WF has many health-promoting effects. We pay attention to each other. Some players are older, some haven't played football before, some are struggling with injuries and playing within limits. ✓ Who can play: Female age 40 or over, male age 50 or over

We have a responsibility to make the best possible arrangements for our own players, so sometimes it won't be possible to have younger guests playing. Guest/young players must show consideration for the playing age group.

✓ Rules!

We have drawn up our own WF game rules enforced by club members who volunteer to act as referee. If we travel to other clubs, their rules will apply.
