- Data Analysis

Only **job ads** and **applications data** for **full-time positions** from **selected industries** and **specialisations** were used to determine the trend of job supply and demand.

→ Data Source

All **job ads** and **applications data** are from **full time job ads** extracted from JobStreet's internal database.



# Overview: Philippines Job Outlook 2022

We use 2 most important markers, **job ads posted** and **job applications** to measure the supply and demand of jobs across different **industries** and **specialisations** in the Philippines.

- 🐈 The unemployment rate has shown a slow recovery with the contraction of the economy.
- 🙀 Job vacancies are affected by Covid-19.




## **Modest Recovery Amidst Adversity**

While job vacancies have increased on JobStreet's platform, the **economy contraction** from COVID-19 in 2020 has affected **job vacancies** and **unemployment rates** in the Philippines.

### Philippines' Lockdown Timeline

#### 15 MARCH - 15 MAY 2020

Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in Metro Manila, NCR, Luzon, and other provinces.

#### 1 MAY 2020

Metro Manila, Calabarzon, Central Luzon (except Aurora) and several other provinces in ECQ while others transition to General Community Quarantine (GCQ).

#### 16 MAY 2020

Metro Manila, cities of Angeles and Bacoor, provinces of Laguna, Bataan, Bulacan, Nueva Ecija, Pampanga, and Zambales under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ).

#### 1 JUNE - 31 DECEMBER 2020

Country alternates between GCQ and MECQ. Metro Manila, Isabela, Santiago City, Batangas, Iloilo, Tacloban City, Lanao del Sur, Iligan City, Davao City, and Davao del Norte enters GCQ, with the rest of the country in MGCQ.

#### 1 JANUARY - 1 APRIL 2021

Provinces alternate between MGCQ and GCQ. [1 - 2k Covid-19 cases]

#### 1 MARCH 2021

Director Dr. Gerardo Legaspi became the first official recipient of Covid-19 vaccine.

#### 1 APRIL - 11 APRIL 2021

NCR+ (Metro Manila, Bulacan, Rizal, Laguna, and Cavite) enters ECQ. [6k - 11k Covid-19 cases]

#### 29 MAY - 11 JUNE 2021

Barangay Namruangan and Bocos Sur placed under 'extreme' ECQ. [5k - 7k Covid-19 cases]

#### 3 JUNE 2021

Only 2% of the country's 109.4M population are fully vaccinated (received 2 doses of vaccination).

#### 21 DECEMBER 2021

The country recorded lowest daily Covid-19 cases for 2021. More than 44M of the country's population fully vaccinated. [168 Covid-19 cases]

















# Industries with Strong Growth and Recovery



## Computer & IT (Software)

#### Industry trends: Job supply and demand




\*The percentage represents the quarter-on-quarter (QoQ) changes in job ads or applications

- ★ The number of ads for Software Developer-related jobs increased by 83.3%, making up 25.6% compared to other job titles.
- ★ 64.8% of the job ads were for **Junior Executive positions**.
- ★ Companies of all sizes, sectors, and locations had embraced digital solutions because of the pandemic, it accounted for 10% of the sales of certain businesses.

#### **Education**

#### Industry trends: Job supply and demand

- \*\* 82.6% of the job ads came from companies with less than 50 employees.
- ★ In early 2021, teachers conducted their classes with a combination of printed modules and materials delivered through TV, radio, and the internet.

#### **Industry trends: Job supply and demand**



- ★ Job ads for **nurses** grew the most at 45.2%, making up 18.3% of the total.
- ★ Job ads by companies with less than 50 employees increased by 84.7%.
- As the country's health system copes with **rising infection numbers**, the government sought to hire 10,000 additional health workers starting Q3 2020.

#### **Telecommunication**

#### **Industry trends: Job supply and demand**

- ★ Junior Executive positions made up the greatest number of job ads at 52.5%.
- Ads for jobs specializing in **Sales & Marketing** increased the most at 76.0%.
- As companies roll out 5G network services, **growth is predicted** for this sector. The government continues to prioritize this industry by allocating at least US\$270.0 million for infrastructures.


## Industries with Gradual Recovery

## **Banking & Financial Services**

#### Industry trends: Job supply and demand



- Accounting-related jobs accounted for the most of the ads at 10.8%, registering a 27.7% growth.
- $\uparrow$  In 2021, the specialization of **Accounting & Finance** accounted for most of the job ads at 55.2%.
- ★ The industry is transforming from the effects of the pandemic. There is a surge in demand for **contactless financial services** due to mobility restrictions.



- 🜟 30.3% of total job ads came from **SMEs**.
- ★ Job ads for Supervisors increased by 54.7%.

- ★ 41.7% of applications were for jobs in companies with more than 5,000 employees.
- 🙀 Job ads for managerial positions increased by 47.2%.
- ★ In July 2021, public infrastructure spending increased 39.1%, achieving the government's target of raising its spending to at least 5% of GDP.

## Construction, Building & Engineering

#### Industry trends: Job supply and demand

- ★ In 2021, **SMEs** posted 5 times more ads and received 3 times more applications compared to corporates.
- ★ Job ads for **Supervisor roles** increased by 44.6%.


## Industries with Modest Recovery

#### **Retail & Merchandise**

#### Industry trends: Job supply and demand

- ★ 40.2% of job ads in the industry came from the Sales & Marketing specialization.
- ★ Job ads from companies with a staff size of 2,001 to 5,000 increased by 108.71%.
- ★ Fashion e-commerce sites have taken the biggest hit as apparel has become less of priority while people are staying home.

### Call Center, IT-Enabled Services & BPO

#### Industry trends: Job supply and demand



- ★ Job ads for **Entry-level positions** had decreased for 2 consecutive years, while **Junior Executive** job ads increased by 48.2% in 2021.
- Ads for jobs specializing in Computer/IT increased by 55.6%.
- with the pandemic, video conferencing solutions became the more cost-effective way to work. US companies turned to Philippines for their customer and operation support needs.

#### Food & Beverage, Catering & Restaurant

#### Industry trends: Job supply and demand



- Ads for jobs specializing in Sales & Marketing increased by 33.3% in 2021.
- ★ Job ads for **Junior Executive positions** increased by 10.6% in 2021.
- The industry was severely impacted by lockdown measures. However, **growing digital platforms** had a positive impact on online food delivery services.

#### **Property & Real Estate**

#### **Industry trends: Job supply and demand**

- ★ 47.1% of ads in 2021 are for jobs specializing in Building & Construction and Accounting & Finance.
- → Job ads from companies with a staff size of **less than 50 employees** shown an increase of 35.0% in 2021.
- → Property prices grew 27.1% year-on-year in Q2 2020, the good performance may be attributed to the attractive payment terms by developers.

## Job Outlook Summary



Hiring activity has rebounded and surpassed pre-covid levels for key industries.



Growth in digital initiatives accelerated by the pandemic resulted in **demand** surges for **tech-related talent**.



In 2021, the majority of the industries (45 out of 51) **posted more job ads** as they adapted to the new normal.




